

The cats languish in their own environment and greet everyone who comes to visit. But that’s just it, not enough people come to visit them. Yes, we are off the beaten path and about 10 miles east of town but, once there, visitors are so impressed with the facilities we have.

For every pet that is adopted from Safe Haven, a space is freed up for another pet to come in. We take dogs to off-site locations but are limited by the number that can be transported. There are so many more beautiful, healthy, well-adjusted pets awaiting a new home right at the sanctuary.
