I have no idea where that name came from but I just knew it fit her. Well when we received her paper work we found out differently, she already had the name of Tinker..

Lorna Harris is the Director of Safe Haven, the first ever no-kill shelter of its kind in Dona Ana County. So I have learned to listen when they speak. I called her and left her the message that Tinker had passed. She called me back and very quickly the whole picture came together.

I think they each knew it was time to leave and why not go together....or at least meet up along the way.
